



ISAF Olympic Class World Championships 2007

The qualification process for country places at the ISAF Olympic Class World Championships 2007 (ISAF Worlds 2007) is outlined by ISAF and is available on the web site www.sailing.org.

This paper outlines the process that the RYA will use to select sailors eligible to represent GBR at the 2007 Worlds.

For all classes the RYA Olympic Steering Group (OSG) shall select the sailors to represent GBR at the ISAF Worlds 2007. The OSG will use the qualification process outlined below as the basis for it's selections.

The RYA reserves the right to send A or B status sailors to the ISAF Worlds 2007.

QUALIFICATION

For all classes except Laser and Laser Radial;

The qualification events shall be the RYA National Ranking Series 2006, defined as;

7 & 8 October	Olympic Class NR	WPNSA
13 – 15 October	Sail For Gold Regatta	WPNSA
28 – 29 October	Olympic Class NR	WPNSA

For the Laser and the Laser Radial the qualification events shall be the RYA National Ranking Series 2006 defined as;

7 & 8 October	UKLA Qualification	Eastbourne
13 – 15 October	Sail For Gold Regatta	WPNSA
28 – 29 October	UKLA Qualification	WPNSA

ENTRY

All sailors intending to race should register on the event web site www.ryaevents.org.uk/sailforgold by 2nd October 2006.

Where any class does not have three entries at 1700hrs on the 2nd October, the qualification series for that class shall be cancelled and places for the 2007 Worlds shall be allocated by the RYA Olympic Steering Group.

FINAL

SCORING

Only boats eligible to represent GBR at the 2007 Worlds will be scored for the purposes of this series.

The National Ranking Series shall be scored as the sum of the overall finishing positions from each of the National Ranking events;

e.g.	7 & 8 October	1 st
	13 – 15 October	3 rd
	28 – 29 October	2 nd
	Total	<u>6 points</u>

Ties shall be broken using the overall finishing order of boats at the Sail for Gold Regatta 2006.
